LOVELY PETS: RABBITS



Choose a cage that will be a house for your rabbits. If you intend to keep the rabbits outside, the corresponding cage will be about 1 meter by 1 meter for a medium-sized rabbit. In addition, about 1/3 of the cage should have a solid bottom and walls to provide the animal with comfort.

The whole should be roofed. You can make a great bed with hay or an old towel. Place the cage in a safe place, away from dogs and other wild animals. On the side of the cage, place a bottle of clean water that you have to exchange every day. A massive stone bowl can be used as a

container for food, it is heavy and it will be difficult to knock it over. A good solution is also special feeders, which are set on the outside of the cage, they are very easy to use. The feeder is also very easy to assemble. You can buy rabbit food at a pet shop or pet food store. It will

be good if you add ordinary oatmeal to the feed, they are very nutritious and the rabbits like them. You have to take care of his health. Hard food, such as alfalfa grains, it is good for domestic rabbits because their teeth are constantly growing. Animals must grind them by biting hard

things. You can also feed rabbits in the form of fibers or give rabbits something to chew on. Throw a carrot into the cage, you can also add a piece of salt that the rabbits can lick. In this way you enrich their food with vitamins and minerals. Most rabbits need about

1/2 cup of food a day. Watch carefully your pet and check how much food it needs. Spend a lot of time playing with your rabbit. The more time you devote to him, the more it will be tamed. You can play with it, brush it or hug it. Breeding rabbits is a very simple and pleasant
